

Included:

- 1. Xitron Network Interface (B3)
- 2. AC/DC Power Adapter
- 3. Xitron Device Interface Cable (model specific)

Note: You can connect to the XNI remotely using Microsoft's Remote Desktop Connection Software or by directly connecting a Monitor, Keyboard, Mouse.

Alternatively, you can use avoid the need for connecting to a mouse, keyboard and monitor by using the R Desktop Connection tool from Microsoft. This tool allows you to control XNI remotely from a different compupreinstalled in most versions of Microsoft Windows and is also available for Apple Mac OS X.
